

Our Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Omnisient (“Omnisient”, “we”, “us”, “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on omnisient.com and related pages that link to this policy. It should be read together with our applicable Privacy Policies, which explain how we process personal data more generally.

By “cookies and similar technologies” we mean cookies, pixels, SDKs, tags, local storage, and other tracking technologies that store or access information on your device. These technologies allow us to store information or gain access to information stored on your device to enable certain features and distinguish your device from others.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work or function more efficiently, as well as to provide information for reporting and improvement purposes.

We also use similar technologies such as pixels, tags, scripts and other identifiers that can perform functions comparable to cookies (for example, to understand how you use our website or whether you have opened an email from us).

Some cookies and similar technologies are set directly by us (“first-party”), while others are set by third parties (“third-party”), such as analytics or advertising providers. Where required by applicable law, we will obtain your consent before using cookies or similar technologies that are not strictly necessary to provide the website and its essential features.

Types of cookies we use

We group the cookies and similar technologies we use into the following categories:

Strictly Necessary

- These are essential for the website to operate or to provide a service you specifically request (for example, to remember your cookie choices, protect forms, route traffic for reliability and security, or allow access to secure areas).

- Because these are strictly necessary and essential to provide you with the services you have requested, they are always active. The website cannot be used properly without strictly necessary cookies.

Functional

- These enhance your experience, for example by remembering your preferences or enabling embedded content (such as YouTube videos) or chat tools.

Analytics/Performance

- These help us understand how our website performs, how visitors interact with the site (for example, which pages are visited and how long people stay), and whether there may be technical issues, so we can improve content and usability.

Advertising/Targeting

- These are used to provide visitors with relevant ads and marketing campaigns and to understand whether our content and campaigns are effective.
- They may be set by us or by our advertising partners and can track your browsing across websites and build a profile of your interests.

Your choices and controls

You have several ways to control cookies and similar technologies:

Cookie banner and Cookie settings

- When you first visit our site, we present a cookie banner that allows you to accept all, reject all non-essential cookies, or customize your choices by category.
- You can change your preferences at any time through 'Cookie Settings' which you can access by clicking on the cookie icon in the bottom left corner of your screen.
- You can also set or amend your browser controls to accept or refuse cookies. If you choose to reject cookies, you may still use our website but your access to some functionality and areas of the site may be limited. As cookie controls differ between browsers, please refer to your browser's help section for more information on how to disable cookies at the browser level.

“Do not Sell or Share My Personal Information” (California)

If you are a California resident, you may exercise your right to opt out of the “sale” or “sharing” of your personal information (as those terms are defined under the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”) and California Privacy Rights Act (“CPRA”).

- You can do this by selecting “Reject All” or disabling Advertising/Targeting cookies in Cookie Settings which you can access by clicking on the cookie icon in the bottom left corner of your screen; and or
- By using the “Do Not Sell or Share My Personal Information” link in our site footer, if available.

Global Privacy Control (GPC) and similar signals

- If your browser or extension sends a Global Privacy Control (GPC) signal or another legally recognized opt-out preference signal, we will honor that choice as a valid opt-out.

We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time, for example to reflect changes to the cookies and similar technologies we use or for other operational, legal or regulatory reasons.
